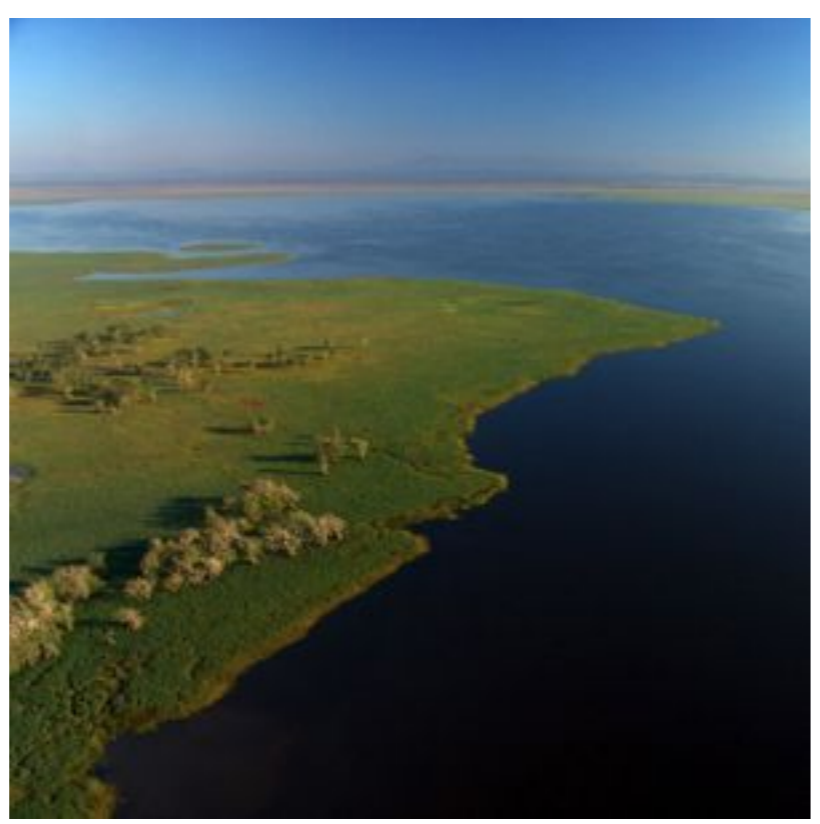
1. Bolivia

This is South America's hidden gem and it's set to make its mark on the tourist scene in 2013. Bolivia packs a massive punch with salt flats, rain forests and mountains all within a rich cultural context.



2. Argentina – wine tour

We've all seen Argentinian wines on the supermarket shelves but to visit and taste these fine wines in the boutique bodegas and modern wineries is a very special experience. We have a 13-night 'Sommelier's Selection' trip, perfect for romantics with a taste for fine wines and spectacular scenery.



3. New Africa camps

Africa continues to up its game when it comes to top notch safari lodges – my pick for 2013 is lesser-known Mozambique, not least with the much-anticipated opening of Barra Lodge Group's three new lodges, by March 2013, in the Gorongosa National Park. It's positively teeming with wildlife and Mozambique has a spectacular coastline, perfect for a safari/beach combo.



4. Out of season India

It may seem counter-intuitive but there's much to be said for visiting India out of season, even during the monsoons. Head to Kerala for a well-being honeymoon focused on Ayurvedic treatments - it's believed locally that the health benefits are enhanced by the rains.



5. Myanmar

6. Maldives
