

Patagonia Camp, Chile

Explore the pristine wilderness of Patagonia and experience the views of Lake Toro from one of just 18 yurts at South America's first luxury camp. Relax on your private terrace or in your room complete with heating, private bathroom, hand woven fabrics and locally handcrafted furniture. Take advantage of Torres del Paine National Park close by, a nature lover's paradise. Prices start at £2,805 per person for a 9-day, 8-night trip.

The Bison, India

Embrace a taste of Africa in India with this authentic and tranquil tented camp located on the banks of the mesmerizing Kabini River in Nagarhole. Where rustic meets luxury, rooms are decorated with wooden floors, writing and dressing tables, arm chairs, artifacts, original antiques, and old cabin trunks. Enjoy a timeless safari with the passionate and experienced naturalists on staff. Evening bonfires here are blissful.

Prices start at £1,630 per person for a 10-day, 9-night southern wildlife and spices trip.

Kicheche Bush Camp, Kenya

With the sweeping view of the Savanna, Mara Plains is a haven of indulgence within the Olare Orok conservancy and the Masai Mara Reserve. Comprising just 6 guest tents with ensuite bathrooms, this is an intimate and exclusive camp with a real personal touch. Relax on your verandah or venture on a peaceful game drive away from the usual safari crowds.

Prices start at £3,150 per person for an 8-day, 7-night luxury Kenya family safari trip.

Lion Safari Camp, India

Gir in the Indian state of Gujurat is the only location in the wild where you'll find Asiatic lions. The Lion Safari Camp is the ideal place to witness them in their natural habitat. Serengeti Under Canvas, Tanzania

Within undoubtedly the best-known wildlife sanctuary in the world, Serengeti Under Canvas luxurious migratory camps follow the path of the famous Serengeti migration, providing incredible opportunities to encounter the countless predators in spacious, chic Bedouin tents. The 8 spacious tents are decorated with crystal chandeliers and even have power outlets for your convenience. Prices start at £2,800 per person for a 12-day, 11-night classic safari in Tanzania and Zanzibar.

Chattra Sagar, India

Situated above a reservoir that gazes across to fields and distant mountains, this luxury camp has a romantic Rajput history. Embrace the exotic cuisine in this lush green oasis and wind-down in one of the 13 hand-stitched tents adorned with locally crafted furniture. The interiors are block printed in traditional floral motifs.

Prices start at £1,985 per person for an 11-day, 10-night introduction to Rajasthan trip.

Leopard Safari, Sri Lanka

An adventurous forest escapade under the open starry skies awaits you in Sri Lanka's Yala National Park. This is not your typical sleeping under canvas experience. The ambience of sleeping under canvas in luxury queen-sized beds and fresh linen is a rather regal experience. When you're not out on a game drive, indulge in fresh tiger afternoon hammock siesta or an aperitif.

Prices start at £2,730 per person for a 12-day, 11-night trip including safaris.

Manu National Park, Peru

In the midst of the southern Peruvian rain forest, lie the authentic huts of the Manu Wildlife Park. Perched on raised platforms the birds-eye views of the surrounding jungle landscapes are absolutely enchanting.

Prices start at £2,025 per person for a 10-day, 9-night trip.
